# **Our Dispensing Service**

The Stockbridge Surgery dispensary is available for use by our patients living more than a mile (1.6 km) as the crow flies, from the nearest pharmacy. We are not permitted to dispense medication for patients living within 1 mile of a pharmacy.

Please do support our dispensary if you can as it is vital in keeping our GP surgery afloat financially.

The dispensary opening hours are:

Monday – Friday 8.30am-12.45pm

1.45pm-6.30pm

Saturday 9.00am-12.00pm

Controlled drugs can **only** be collected from Stockbridge between 9.00am-12.45pm and 1.45-5.00pm Monday-Friday.

The dispensary is managed by Patricia Chin. She has a dedicated team of dispensers who run an efficient, well organised service.

In order to ensure patient safety and minimise waste a 28 day supply of medication is prescribed.

We pride ourselves in holding a large stock of medicines; we can usually provide you with medication to treat acute illnesses before you leave the surgery. On rare occasions we may have to obtain them from our suppliers; usually within 24 hours.

# **Ordering medication**

Please allow up to 5 working days (Monday-Friday, excluding weekends and bank holidays) from requesting your repeat medication before collecting it. If you provide your mobile number we will text you when your medication is ready.

There are 3 ways to order medication:

## 1 NHS App / Online

You can order medication easily and quickly by downloading the NHS App.

#### 2 **In person**

Use the repeat medication form enclosed with medicines. Simply tick the required items and leave the form at your usual drop off point i.e. one of our surgeries or at the appropriate village post office / shop.

#### 3 **Post**

Mail the repeat form or a clearly written request to Stockbridge Surgery.

# **Collection & Delivery**

Patients can arrange to collect medication from our Broughton site. Broughton site is open:

Monday-Friday 8.30am-12.45pm 1.45pm-5.30pm

For housebound patients we provide a collection and delivery service—please contact the dispensary if interested.

Three times a week we deliver to the post-offices at Chilbolton, King's Somborne, and Over Wallop and once a week to local shops in Lockerly and the West Tytherley areas.

Controlled medication and fridge items cannot be sent to local shops.

We pick up all repeat medication requests as they all need to be processed by us. For our dispensing patients we will deliver your medication back to the appropriate village post office, usually within three working days.

Non dispensing patients should nominate a local pharmacy and your prescription will be ready to collect directly from them without the need to visit the surgery.
