Covid Vaccination

If you received the Spring Covid booster, you can have the Autumn booster from 1 October 2025. The criteria are patients aged 75 and over and patients who are immunosuppressed. If you think you are immunosuppressed but have not received an invitation to book an appointment by 26 September, please check our website: stockbridgesurgery.co.uk for further information.

Flu Vaccination

The criteria for flu vaccination are the same as in recent years; adults aged 65 and over, people in a clinical risk group, pregnant women and carers.

Vaccination Clinics

We will be holding flu and covid vaccination clinics at our Broughton Surgery on Friday 3 October, Saturday 4 October and Friday 17 October. There should be a 6-month gap between Covid boosters and, depending on when you had your spring booster, you may need to wait until 17 October to have your Autumn booster. We will be giving the Covid and flu vaccination together if you are eligible for both.

Please wait until you receive an invitation before booking and book online using the link if possible.

Unwanted medication

We can only take back medication which has been issued by us. We recently received a large quantity of medication including paracetamol and animal medication. It is time consuming to properly dispose of medication so please sort any medication before you bring it to the surgery.

Blood Pressure

Blood Pressure UK are encouraging everyone to 'Know your numbers' by checking their blood pressure. If you are aged over 45 years and haven't had your blood pressure checked in the last 5 years, please consider using the machine in our waiting rooms.
