Orthopaedic referrals – How they work

When a GP wants to refer a patient to orthopaedics, they must refer to Orthopaedic Choice, a triage service running out of Lymington Hospital. When Orthopaedic Choice receive the referral, they triage to the most suitable clinician, either a physio or consultant. If triaged to a consultant, you will receive a letter with a list of hospitals to choose from. GPs can request a specific consultant, but this cannot be guaranteed.

When we make a referral, you will receive a letter from us confirming the referral to Lymington Hospital, please be aware this does not mean you have to go to this hospital to be seen.
