

### Infection Prevention Compliance Statement

Stockbridge Practice takes its responsibility to ensure the safety of patients, staff and visitors very seriously. This includes minimising the risk of infection transmission.

All staff receive infection control training as part of their induction. Clinical staff are required to have training every 2 years and non-clinical staff every 3 years.

Infection Prevention Audits are undertaken quarterly in accordance with the Hants and IOW requirements. Following audits, action plans are put in place.

Staff are encouraged to report all incidents and near misses. These are discussed at a monthly Learning Event Meeting to identify learning and actions to be put into place. The learning is shared with all staff.


